### **Questions:**

1. What does the word disciple mean to you?  
Jesus calls his disciples to Himself. Do you identify with this idea that you too have been 'called' to be one of Jesus' disciples?
2. The disciples were called to do two things: Be with Jesus and be sent out to preach the gospel. How do you spend time with Jesus? Is this easy or hard to do? Do you have a favourite time or place?
3. Has there been a time in your life when you have felt completely and utterly dependent on God?
4. How would you feel if you were one of the disciples being sent out without money or a bag? What enabled the twelve disciples to take up Jesus' commission to share the gospel, heal the sick and drive out impure Spirits?
5. How easy do you find it to talk to those around you about your faith in Jesus? What makes it difficult / easy?

## **OUT : SHARING IN GOD'S MISSION**

As you go about your day have you tried praying continuously or praying in tongues throughout the day. I have found this incredibly helpful to live my day with God and look out for God given opportunities. Why not try this and see where God leads you. Challenge each other to share a story next week about how God has led you into something.
